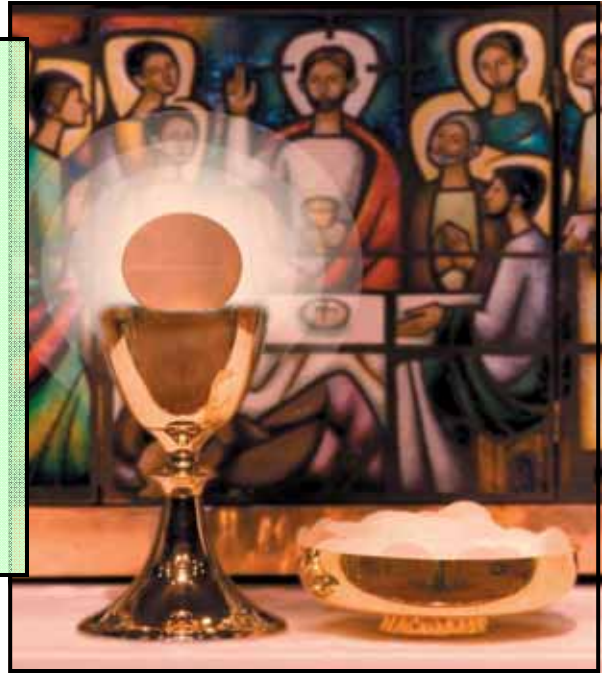


Understand the Symbolism of the Mass

Before Vatican II, Carl Jung wrote, "It is the role of religious symbols to give meaning to the life of man." This presentation will examine the symbolism of the Mass today while weaving Jung's original thoughts in the context of those changes. The divine element of ritual, including its symbolisms, is ever present, hidden in ancient gestures, that continues to stir something within us. But has something new emerged? What meanings does the Mass impart for the body? Retreat will conclude with Mass.

Fr. William Axe is a Roman Catholic priest who specializes in the Hebrew Scriptures. He has been involved in prison work, AIDS ministry and retreats. He is serving in an inner-city parish in LA.
